The lodging is in spacious, 2 level condo's with the upper level having a large living room and one bedroom and the lower level having the 2nd bedroom, a small living room and the kitchen unit. The smaller living room has a wall unit queen sized Murphy bed. It is our intention to have 4 people per condo with a couple in one bedroom, one person in the other bedroom and another single in the Murphy bed. We are offering a limited time discount to groups of 4 who take a whole condo and to couples (see below). The 2nd bedroom and Murphy beds will be assigned based on date full payment has been received. Under NO circumstances will we assign 2 people to the 2nd bedroom.
